1. Junior Classes only - Cash prizes and ribbons will be awarded to all 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place in Junior classes. Children may collect their cash prizes or other money prizes (EXCLUDING RIBBONS AND EXHIBITS) anytime from 11:00 am to 4:30pm on Saturday September 10<sup>th</sup> at the Red Ribbon Front Desk in the curling rink.

## FRUIT

### Class

- 600 APPLES – 3, name of variety
- 601 **NEW** BLACK or RED CURRANTS - 3 clusters
- 602 **NEW** CRAB APPLE – stems attached, plate of 6
- 603 GOOSEBERRY - 5, cleaned
- 604 PUMPKIN – 1 fruit
- 605 RASPBERRY - 5, cleaned with stem attached
- 606 SASKATOON BERRY - 5, cleaned
- 607 STRAWBERRY - 5, cleaned
- 608 TOMATOES (Green) – 3, with stem
- 609 TOMATOES (Red) – 3, with stem
- 610 TOMATOES (Yellow) – 3, with stem
- 611 TOMATOES (Cherry) – 5, on the vine
- 612 **NEW** ANY VARIETY OF SMALL FRUIT – 3
- 613 **NEW** ANY VARIETY OF LARGE FRUIT – 3

## VEGETABLES

### Class

- 614 BEANS (Green String or bush) – 5 pods
- 615 BEANS (Yellow String or Wax) – 5 pods
- 616 BEETS (Red) – 3, tops trimmed to 1" (2.54cm) above crown, main root trimmed
- 617 BEETS (Yellow) – 3, tops trimmed to 1" (2.54cm) above crown, main root trimmed
- 618 BEETS (Other) – 3, tops trimmed to 1" (2.54cm) above crown, main root trimmed
- 619 CABBAGE – 1 head, 5"-8" (12.7cm-20.32cm) diameter
- 620 CARROTS – 3 medium, up to and including 7" (17.8cm), tops trimmed to 1/2"
- 621 CARROTS – 3 long, over 7" (17.8cm), tops trimmed to 1/2"
- 622 CELERY - 3 stems
- 623 CORN – 2 ears, sweet variety, 1/3 of husk removed lengthwise
- 624 CORN - 2 ears, ornamental variety, 1/3 of husk removed lengthwise
- 625 CUCUMBERS (Pickling) – 3, 3/8" (1 cm) stem attached
- 626 CUCUMBERS (Slicing) – 2, 3/8" (1 cm) stem attached
- 627 GARLIC – 3 heads
- 628 KALE - 3, with stem
- 629 LOVAGE - 3 stems
- 630 ONIONS (Red) – 3, slicing variety, tops and root trimmed to 1/2" (1.27cm)
- 631 ONIONS (White) – 3, slicing variety, tops and root trimmed to 1/2" (1.27cm)
- 632 ONIONS (Yellow) – 3, slicing variety, tops and root trimmed to 1/2" (1.27cm)
- 633 ONIONS (Green) – 5, bunched together, tops and roots neatly trimmed
- 634 PEAS – 5 pods
- 635 PEAS, SNAP - 5 pods
- 636 PEPPERS, SWEET – 2 fruit
- 637 PEPPERS, HOT - 2 fruit

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- 638 POTATOES (Any skin colour other than red or white) – 3, cleaned
- 639 POTATOES (Red) – 3, cleaned
- 640 POTATOES (White) – 3, cleaned
- 641 RHUBARB – 3 stems pulled, leaves trimmed to fan shape
- 642 SQUASH – 1 fruit, any kind excluding zucchini
- 643 SWISS CHARD – 3, with stem
- 644 ZUCCHINI SMALL– 3, 3/8 in (1cm) stem attached, size 8"-10" (20.3cm-25.4cm)
- 645 ZUCCHINI LARGE BAKING – 1, 3/8" (1 cm) stem attached, size over 10" (25.4cm)
- 646 ANY OTHER VEGETABLE – 3

### HERBS

#### **Class**

- 647 HERBS – collection of 5 different herbs in a jar, name the varieties

### DISPLAYS

#### **Class**

- 648 **NEW** BASKET OF SALAD VEGETABLES - displayed in an attractive manner
- 649 **NEW** POT OF STEW VEGETABLES - displayed in an attractive manner
- 650 VEGGIE DISPLAY - an arrangement of fresh homegrow vegetables and vegetable foliage

### JUNIOR FRUIT & VEGETABLES - 6 & UNDER

#### **Class**

- 652 BEST DRESSED VEGETABLE – one vegetable
- 653 CROOKED CARROT - top trimmed to 1 cm and roots neatly trimmed
- 654 FRUIT - 3, same variety
- 655 HEAVIEST ZUCCHINI
- 656 LONGEST CARROT - top trimmed to 1 cm and roots neatly trimmed
- 657 ODD SHAPED VEGETABLE
- 658 RHUBARB - 3 stalks, uniform in shape and size

### JUNIOR FRUIT & VEGETABLES - AGES 7 - 12

#### **Class**

- 659 BEST DRESSED VEGETABLE – one vegetable
- 660 CROOKED CARROT - top trimmed to 1 cm and roots neatly trimmed
- 661 FRUIT - 3, same variety
- 662 HEAVIEST PUMPKIN
- 663 HERB GARDEN - must use at least three herbs
- 664 LONGEST CARROT - top trimmed to 1 cm and roots neatly trimmed
- 665 ODD SHAPED VEGETABLE
- 666 RHUBARB - 3 stalks, uniform in shape and size

### JUNIOR FRUIT & VEGETABLES - 17 & UNDER

#### **Class**

- 667 CARROTS – 3, any kind, tops trimmed to 1/2" and roots neatly trimmed
- 668 FRUIT - 3, same variety
- 669 ITEM CONSTRUCTED WITH VEGETABLE - Small accessories allowed. Examples include zuchinni car etc...
- 670 ONIONS - 3, any kind, skins left on and uniform in size
- 671 PEAS - 5 pods, any kind
- 672 POTATOES - 3, any kind, clean and uniform in size
- 673 RHUBARB - 3 stalks, uniform in shape and size
